

SCHOOL ATTORNEY

The School Board may retain an attorney for legal counsel and services. The superintendent is authorized to make use of such counsel as needed.

The school attorney, upon request by the School Board, may attend regular meetings of the Board and other meetings of the Board or its committees.

The school attorney will be sufficiently familiar with the requirements of the school laws of the state to enable him or her to offer the necessary advice.
