

TRAFFIC AND PARKING CONTROLS

Vehicle Safety

Bicycles may be ridden to school provided they are operated in a safe manner. Riders must obey all highway safety procedures. They shall confine their riding to roadways. They must remain in the proper lane of traffic at all times. Parking shall be at a designated location.

Skateboards are not allowed on school property.

Pupils may drive automobiles to high school provided they have a valid operator's license and obey all school and state regulations concerning the operation of a motor vehicle. Driving is a privilege and there are many responsibilities entailed in the use of a motor vehicle.

Pupils driving to school must have permission from their parents. They will park only in places designated for pupil parking. Once a pupil has arrived at school the student may not leave the school in the automobile until the end of the school day without permission of an administrator. The principal may suspend a pupil's right to drive to school for failure to abide by the rules and regulations.

Middle school pupils and elementary school pupils may not drive automobiles to school.

Walking Safety

Pupils walking to schools should remain on the sidewalk. Where no sidewalks are provided, the pupils should walk facing the traffic.
