

STAFF PARTICIPATION IN POLITICAL ACTIVITIES

The Waynesboro School Board recognizes the right of its employees to engage in political activity. Employees may solicit support for political candidates or political issues outside regular work hours, and off school property.

School employees engaging in political activity must make it clear that their views and actions are made as individuals and that they do not represent the views of the school division.
