

PROGRAMS FOR GIFTED STUDENTS

To provide acceptable programs for gifted students educational opportunities appropriate to exceptional abilities must be provided. The responsibility of providing each student with the opportunity to realize his/her potential is recognized by the Waynesboro School Board. Gifted students require a unique, advanced, and challenging educational program in order to enhance the development of their special abilities.

It is the position of the school board to actively promote and develop an appropriately differentiated educational program for gifted students in order to facilitate the fullest development of their potential. The program shall be in compliance with the standards of quality as cited in the legal reference to this policy.
