

## **POST-SECONDARY STUDENTS**

### Admission of Pupils Twenty Years of Age

Persons twenty (20) years of age and above who reside in Waynesboro, may, at the discretion of the school board, attend the public schools. Such pupils must agree to the regulations prescribed by the board and school and will not impair the efficiency of the school. Tuition charges may be required of such pupils.

### Postgraduate Pupils

Waynesboro High School courses will be open to such pupils as class enrollment permits, subject to the approval of the high school principal and guidance department.

The postgraduate pupil will not be eligible for undergraduate offices, honor societies, or activities where membership in a class is required, but he will be considered as an enrolled Waynesboro High School pupil with the responsibilities, privileges, and rights of the student body.

Postgraduate students over twenty (20) years of age, will pay tuition based on the per capita cost of education for the previous year.
