

ADULT EDUCATION

The superintendent is authorized to offer an Adult Basic Education Program to those members of the community who have not successfully completed the eighth grade or higher. In addition, the superintendent is authorized to offer a General Education Development Program for adults who have not earned a high school diploma and who wish to prepare for the General Education Development Program Examination. Additional educational programs for adults may be offered. Tuition charges will be established by the school board.
