

CLASS SIZE

The board expects that class sizes generally will be consistent with those set forth in the Standards of Quality.

The board recognizes that new forms of school organizations and innovations will govern the number of students assigned to a group. The basic concern of the board is that the size of the class be educationally sound and suited to the needs of the students.

It is recognized that, on the secondary level, the total daily student load of the teacher is more important than the size of any one class.
