

**STUDENT COMPLAINTS REGARDING DISCRIMINATION  
ON THE BASIS OF SEX**

The board hereby establishes a policy and the superintendent shall implement procedures for resolving complaints arising from alleged violations of Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (P.L. 92-318 as amended (P.L. 93-568 and P.L. 94-482).

The superintendent shall designate at least one employee to coordinate the efforts of the Waynesboro Public Schools to comply with and carry out its responsibilities for implementing the law, including investigation of any complaint of alleged noncompliance with the law or accompanying regulations.

The school system shall notify student, parents of students, and employees of the name, office address, and telephone number of the Title IX specialist through the permanent, prominent display of posters prepared for this purpose, as well as any other appropriate communication channels such as school handbooks, Waynesboro Public Schools publications, etc.

The school system shall implement specific and continuing steps to notify student and parents that it does not discriminate on the basis of sex in educational programs and activities and that it is required by Title IX not to discriminate.

Procedures for making and resolving such complaints shall comply with all applicable federal and state law and regulations.
