

## **PUBLIC INFORMATION PROGRAM**

The community shall be kept informed regarding the educational program provided for the instruction of all students since the schools closely touch the lives of all persons in the community. The board shall use all available media of communication to keep themselves and the public informed regarding the policies, administration, program, operation, needs, and objectives of the schools.

Since school publications are one means by which the public evaluates the schools, publications shall receive careful faculty supervision as well as approval of the principal to ensure acceptable standards of content and journalism.
