

Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

Waynesboro Public Schools (WPS) will provide an AED Public Access Defibrillation Program for our schools and community members that use WPS buildings. Our school buildings and Central Office will house at least one AED unit in an alarmed wall mount located in common areas where large numbers of persons may gather. An additional AED unit is housed with the Athletic Trainers at the high school for use with sporting events. All persons trained in CPR/AED may respond to medical emergencies using the AED. Each building has a minimum of two trained responders. Training is available to any staff member through classes held throughout the school year. Call Emergency Medical Services (9-1-1) immediately upon activation of the Emergency Medical Response Plan.

Protocol and procedures (AED School-Based Public Access Defibrillation Program and Emergency Medical Response Plan) can be found with Administrators, Athletic Directors, Athletic Trainers and School Nurses.
