



# Phase III COVID-19 Instruction Plan 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

## TWO INSTRUCTIONAL MODELS

- **Option 1: 100% Remote Learning at Home** (Online, Virtual, and Packet Instruction)
  - Instruction is provided by instructional staff in Waynesboro
  - Internet ready devices and/or wireless hotspots will be provided for students in need
- **Option 2: Hybrid Learning Model** (In-person and Remote Learning at Home)
  - Students attend school 2 days a week and learn at home 3 days a week.
  - Students with last names A-L attend school Tuesdays and Thursdays.
  - Students with last names M-Z attend school Wednesdays and Friday.
  - Mondays are planning and preparation days for instructional staff.
  - Siblings with different last names will attend school together.
  - Internet ready devices and/or wireless hotspots will be provided for students in need.

## CONSIDERATIONS FOR ALL LEARNERS

- Students will have required and graded assignments
- Virginia Standards of Learning aligned instruction by Waynesboro educators
- A full catalog of course offerings
- Canvas Learning Management System will serve as a learning platform
- Pacing Guides and curriculum have been modified to include learning opportunities from the last nine weeks of the 2019-2020 school year.
- JumpStart 2020 summer program available to all elementary students to include content that would have been covered mid-March-May 2020

## SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- School leaders and teachers are aware that there are groups of children who are more vulnerable to learning challenges using a remote or hybrid learning model.
- Students with disabilities, English language learners, and our youngest students may be able to increase their in-school time after schools have individualized discussions with families about student needs.
- Students may move between instructional models with 7 days of notice to the principal. The principal will determine with division leadership about how to best accommodate parent and student requests.
