

INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS DISCRIMINATION

No person may be subjected to discrimination based on sex in any scholastic club or intramural athletics.

Separate teams for each sex are permissible in contact sports or where selection for teams is based on competitive skill. Contact sports include boxing, wrestling, football, basketball, and any other sport "the purpose or major activity of which involves bodily contact".

In noncontact sports, whenever a school has a team in a given sport for one sex only, and athletic opportunities for the other sex have been limited, members of both sexes must be allowed to try out for the team.

Equal athletic opportunities must be given for both sexes; however, equal expenditures are not necessarily required.
